EMHC’s assist the priest at the celebration of the Eucharist (Mass) to distribute the Body and the Blood of Christ to the faithful. EMHC’s must be baptized Catholics, confirmed and under no canonical penalty. They must also be registered active Catholics (attending Mass regularly) who are at least 16 years of age.
